### Penang Treasure Trail

One of the better ways to venture through the streets of Penang or explore around the island will be by car. To add some element of fun, excitement or even team building, a treasure hunt cum photo safari can be incorporated into the tour. All decorated cars will be lined up while “Clues”, a scavenger list and a goody bag will be handed out to every participant. The hunt requires your guests to travel and explore the state in order to answer the questions or take the photos listed in the customised scavenger list. There are rural villages to stop over in cottage industries to purchase local handicrafts from tatty fishing villages balanced on stilts and acres of fruit orchards. Your guests will discover Penang – The City of Living Culture. From her heritage trail sites to her diverse places of worship, you can learn her history and experience the culture of her people.

## Safari Hunt In Langkawi

Langkawi, the island of legends is only twenty minutes away by air from Penang. If your guests prefer to experience the inspiring beauty of the archipelago of islands, board a ferry (2½ hour ride) instead.

Your guests will be given a thorough brief prior to being flagged off for the treasure hunt.

A four-wheel drive vehicle will be provided for every team. Each will be furnished with a treasure kit including a list of interesting questions related to the island exploration. Locals can be seen busy at work but always generous with a smile. The hunt will end at the north-western end of Langkawi.

This dense mangrove swamp area is home not only to a fascinating diversity of wildlife and vegetation but also an exquisite Thai restaurant. Lunch will be served here. Before you return to Penang, you will have an opportunity to pick up some souvenirs in Kuah Town - the island's main township.

## The Enchanting Gua Tempurung

Just a 2-hour drive from Penang to the Silver State of Perak, your guests' begin their journey to Perak's best-kept secret – *Gua Tempurung*. Believed to be one of the largest and most majestic white marble and limestone formations in Malaysia, the caves conjure up images of mystery and intrigue. With different calcium formations and marble that exist in differing temperatures and water levels, bats can be heard squealing throughout the high caverns, lending a very surreal atmosphere to the whole exploration. These caves are famous for their awe-inspiring gallery of stalagmites, stalactites and incredible rock formations which are the only such wonders found in this part of the world. Guests who are new to this kind of adventure will be reassured with the caves' carefully constructed walkways and platforms that make excursions into these complex caves a breeze.

### SPECIAL NOTES

Bring a change of clothes and shoes. Wear comfortable walking or hiking shoes. Torchlights and helmets are available for rent if required.

### ENHANCEMENTS

1. Chinese lunch at the locality or lunch at Clearwater Sanctuary Bay – an old-mining pool-turned-golf resort. Here you get to visit a replica of the Thai palace and courtyard of the Hollywood production, *Anna and the King!*
