Kuala Lumpur's Green Lung

Just 45 minutes away from Kuala Lumpur, the Forest Research Institute of Malaysia (FRIM) in Kepong is literally off the beaten track. FRIM has a worldwide reputation as a centre of excellence in forestry research. Your guests will walk on the rainforest canopy walkway that offers a 20-minute respite and provides a unique view of Kuala Lumpur's skyscrapers through the trees. You will hear the high-pitched sound made by an insect called cicada and if you observe your surroundings during your walk, you are likely to see birds, small mammals and reptiles.

The second half of the walk takes your guests through a sub-ethnic village of Malaysia's *asli* (indigenous people) called "Temuan". And during the fruit season, your guests will be able to see fruit orchards abloom in this village. A knowledgeable guide will also impart interesting facts on the flora and fauna available in the Malaysian jungle.

CONSIDERATIONS

The average time taken for a round trip is 2 hours.

WHAT TO WEAR & BRING:

Good walking/hiking shoes. Extra change of clothes

ENHANCEMENTS

1. Picnic lunch under the shade of trees (minimum group size of 40 persons).
2. Survival bag containing insect repellent, drinking water and face towels.
